
Dear Zwaanendael Sisters,

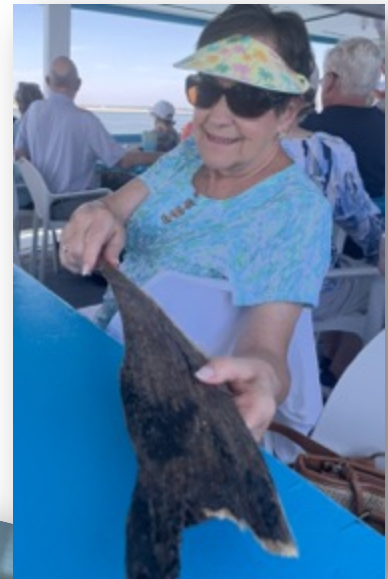
